Building & Development

You must obtain the necessary *Development Permits* from the Town office before beginning any type of development.

All proposed developments must have the Development Permit Application approved PRIOR to the Building Application being reviewed (in most cases). Construction CANNOT begin until the Building Application has been approved and a Building Permit has been issued.

Property Taxes

Your annual property tax notice will include municipal taxes, as well as taxes imposed by other taxing authorities like school divisions or library boards. The taxation year is the same as the calendar year, January 1 – December 31, with property taxes due December 31. You will receive a five (5) per cent discount on the municipal portion of taxes if you pay by July 31.

Tax notices are sent to property owners at the end of May beginning of June. If your current year's taxes remain unpaid after December 31 they are considered to be in arrears. Arrears are subject to a penalty at a compound rate of 1.25% per month, added on the first day of each month until paid. Penalties added to arrears are considered part of the tax arrears. Dog Licensing

Every person who owns, possesses or harbors any dog over the age of 3 months shall, within 30 days of becoming an owner or bringing the dog into the Town, obtain a dog license from the Town Office.

Tags are \$50 for Lifetime if dog is fixed and \$100 for Lifetime if dog is not fixed.

Please also ensure your dog is leashed & wearing a collar with the tag issued by the Town when your dog is off your premises.

Parks & Recreation provides many benefits to the community. Our programs provide places for health and well-being that are accessible by persons of all ages and abilities. We have a multitude of exciting programs for all ages...there's something for everyone!

South Shore Parks & Recreation (Regina Beach & Buena Vista) provides both indoor and outdoor leisure and recreation opportunities by encouraging all residents to be physically active through services and programs that are accessible and affordable.

The South Shore Rec Centre (South Shore School Gym) is a shared facility between the Town of Regina Beach, the Village of Buena Vista and Prairie Valley School Division. The multi-purpose facility equipped with a spacious gym is ideal for many recreational programs & activities, and is the main facility used by South Shore Parks & Recreation.

Lions Park, located at the top of Centre Street, offers play structures, basketball and pickleball courts, Picnic areas with bbq's in the summer. Also included in Lions Park is our Ball Diamond. Lorne Mack Ball Diamond is home to the Regina Beach Rebels (ladies team) and the Regina Beach Pikers (men's team).

Stay active during the winter months by visiting our outdoor rink located on MacMurchy Avenue. The Regina Beach Outdoor Rink is the hub of activity in the winter months. Whether you are looking to play shinny hockey, enjoy recreational skating or wanting to learn to skate.
