## BYLAW 02/2017

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF REGINA BEACH TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 09/2016 BEING A BYLAW TO REGULATE AND CONTROL THE USE AND CONSUMPTION OF WATER FROM THE MUNICIPALITY'S WATER WORKS SYSTEM

The Council of the Town of Regina Beach, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts to amend Bylaw No. 09/2016 as follows:

- 1. Section 7 be **replaced** with the following:
  - 7. A water service will not be activated until:
    - There is a permanent dwelling, as defined in the Town of Regina Beach Zoning Bylaw, constructed on the property;
    - A water meter, as supplied by the Municipality, has been installed in a safe and accessible location;
    - There is a holding tank installed per Public Health regulations;

## And on condition:

• The installation of the water meter must be done by a Public Works and Utilities employee or a qualified tradesperson at the expense of the consumer.

## 2. Section 13 be **replaced** with the following:

## 13. Seasonal water lines:

- May 1<sup>st</sup> through to September 30<sup>th</sup> is the water connection (turn on) and water disconnection (turn off) period for seasonal water lines.
- If May 1st falls on a weekend day, the turn on date will move to the Friday before.
- If September 30<sup>th</sup> falls on a weekend day, the turn off date will move to the Monday following.
- If the turn on or turn off date must or can be changed due to extenuating circumstances or favourable/unfavourable weather this will be determined by resolution of Council.
- It is the consumer's responsibility to request the turn on or turn off date each year no later than 3 p.m. two business days prior to requested turn on/turn off date. Availability of requested date is not guaranteed.

- If the Town office does not receive a request from the property owner to schedule a turn off date, there will be a \$10.00 administrative charge applied to the respective utility account.
- If deemed by the Municipality that the consumer or a representative of the consumer must be present during the turn on or turn off, that will be indicated to the consumer or representative at the time of booking.
- 3. This bylaw shall come in to force and take effect when adopted by Council.
