
A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF REGINA BEACH  
TO AUTHORIZE THE OPERATION OF ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES  
WITHIN TOWN LIMITS

The Council of the Town of Regina Beach, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. To enable the Royal Canadian Mounted Police to provide enforcement and service to the Town, authorization is given for the use and operation of All Terrain Vehicles within the Town limits by police personnel only.
2. To enable provincial utility companies to provide their services to the Town, authorization is given for the use and operation of All Terrain Vehicles within the Town limits by their staff.
3. To enable the Town of Regina Beach to provide municipal services within the Town, authorization is given for the use and operation of All Terrain Vehicles within the Town by their staff.
4. Bylaws 6/2000, 2/2007 and 5/2007 are hereby repealed.
