

BYLAW 05/2016

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF REGINA BEACH
TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 1/2006
BEING THE NUISANCE ABATEMENT BYLAW

The Council of the Town of Regina Beach, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts to amend Bylaw No. 1/2006 as follows:

1. Addition:

DEFINITIONS

- l) **“town property”** means any property owned, leased, or under the jurisdiction and control of the Town of Regina Beach including, but not limited to, roads, road allowances, undeveloped road allowances, streets, lanes, buffer strips, or public reserve.

2. Addition:

ENCUMBRANCE OF TOWN PROPERTY

10.1 No person shall encumber town property.

No town property shall be used for the exhibition or storage of any vehicle, machinery, other equipment, other article, object or thing.

No person shall place or store any vehicle, machinery, other equipment, other article, object or thing of any kind upon any town property.

No person shall place or leave on or within any municipal road any earth, stones, snow, rubbish, fences, or other objects without the express permission of Council.

The municipality may remove any unauthorized vehicle, machinery or other equipment, other article, object or thing placed, left, or maintained on town property at the cost of the person who caused or allowed the vehicle, machinery or other equipment, other article, object or thing to be placed, left or maintained and may destroy or otherwise dispose of the vehicle, machinery, other equipment, other article, object or thing.

3. Addition

RECOVERY OF UNPAID EXPENSES AND COSTS:

c) by selling any vehicle, machinery, other equipment, other article, object or thing.

4. This Bylaw shall come into force on the day of its adoption


