


BYLAW 14/2016

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF REGINA BEACH TO
AMEND BYLAW NO. 10/2016 BEING A BYLAW TO FIX THE RATES TO BE
CHARGED FOR THE USE AND CONSUMPTION OF WATER FROM THE
MUNICIPALITY'S
WATER WORKS SYSTEM

The Council of the Town of Regina Beach, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts to amend Bylaw No. 10/2016 as follows:

1. Section 3 be **amended** as follows:
 3. *Accounts are to be paid by the end of the month following the end of the billing period. If an account is not paid by the end of the month following the end of the billing period, it is considered arrears, and a penalty of 1%, compounded interest per month, will be applied on the 1st of each month. Unpaid arrears may result in discontinuation of service. Service will be restored once all arrears and turn off and turn on fees are paid in full.*
2. This bylaw shall come in to force and take effect on adoption by Council.


