The permanent capital fund is protected and spins off annual interest which provides funds as identified to support local projects. At present we provide a bursary to one community minded graduate of Lumsden Highschool and the South Shore School Playground Committee.

As the fund is managed by the South Sask Community Foundation the time commitment for volunteers is minimal and basically involves making sure the annual funds continue to go to a worthy cause.
