

**BYLAW 03/2014**

**A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF REGINA BEACH  
TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 2/2002 BEING A BYLAW TO  
DESIGNATE MUNICIPAL HERITAGE PROPERTY**

WHEREAS Sections 11 and 12 of *The Heritage Property Act* authorizes the Council of a Municipality to enact bylaws to designate real property, including all buildings, features and structures thereon, to be of heritage value; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Regina Beach enacts to amend Bylaw 02/2002 a Bylaw to Designate Municipal Heritage Property by **adding**:

Determining that the lands and premises known as:

Lakeside Heritage Museum current and future museum site

and located at:

Lots 18, 19, 20, 21, 22 and 23, Block 14, Plan 86R56124  
1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 Brewer Bay

is a site of architectural, historical, cultural, environmental, archaeological, paleontological, aesthetic and/or scientific value; and,

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Regina Beach has caused, not less than thirty (30) days prior to consideration of this bylaw, a Notice of Intention to Designate to be:

- a) served on owners of the said property;
- b) served on the Registrar of Heritage Property;
- c) registered on the Certificate of Title for said property in the appropriate Land Titles Office,
- d) published in at least one issue of a newspaper with general circulation in the municipality; and,

WHEREAS no Notice of Objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Council of the Town of Regina Beach;

THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Regina Beach enacts to amend Bylaw 02/2002 as follows:

1. There is designated as Municipal Heritage Property the real property legally described as:

Lots 18, 19, 20, 21, 22 and 23, Block 14, Plan 86R56124

The reason for the designation is as follows:

- a) to provide for an additional site for the preservation and display of Regina Beach and district historical items.
2. The Town of Regina Beach Chief Administrative Officer is hereby authorized to cause a Notice of Designation to be:
    - a) registered on the Certificate of Title for said property at the appropriate Land Titles Office; and,
    - b) served on the owners of said property.
  3. The Town of Regina Beach Chief Administrative Officer is hereby authorized to cause a certified copy of this bylaw to be served on the Registrar of Heritage Property.
