

Rules of Attending as a Delegation

- The delegate has 15 minutes to present their subject matter
- The delegate may speak only once, during presentation time
- Rebuttal or cross debate with other delegations not allowed
- If numerous delegates are attending on the same matter a spokesperson must be appointed
- Any cross communications between council and delegates will be limited to council requesting clarification on a matter or requesting additional relevant information
- When addressing members at a council meeting, a delegate shall refrain from:
 - (a) speaking disrespectfully of the federal government, the provincial government or another municipal council, or any official representing them;
 - (b) using offensive words in referring to a member, an employee of the municipality or a member of the public;
 - (c) reflecting on a vote of council except when moving to rescind or reconsider it;
 - (d) reflecting on the motives of the members who voted on the motion or the mover of the motion; or
 - (e) shouting or using an immoderate tone, profane, vulgar or offensive language
