

BYLAW NO. 06/2018

**A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF REGINA BEACH
TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 1/2006
BEING THE NUISANCE ABATEMENT BYLAW**

The Council of the Town of Regina Beach in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts TO AMEND Bylaw No. 1/2006 as follows:

1. Addition:

ENCUMBRANCE OF TOWN PROPERTY

10.2 No person shall leave or store any item such as, but not limited to, boats, trailers, ice shacks, at the location identified as SE 21-21-22-2, Plan 101410827, Ext 87, Parcel 111470183, where the Town has an identifying sign stating that no storage of any kind and no overnight parking is allowed.

The identifying sign states that violators will be towed at the owners' expense. Any violators will have a notice posted on the offending item and will have one week to remove the item before the Town will proceed to tow the item.

2. This bylaw shall come into force on the date of adoption by Council.
