

BYLAW 17/2017

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF REGINA BEACH TO
AMEND BYLAW NO. 11/2005 BEING THE ZONING BYLAW

The Council of the Town of Regina Beach, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts to amend Bylaw No. 11/2005 as follows:

1. Section 6.2 is *amended* as follows:

The following sub-section is to be *added* to Section 6.2:

(5) A-Board signs, with a maximum sign facial area not exceeding 1.2 m² (13 ft²), shall be allowed to be placed on a public roadway, boulevard or sidewalk when advertising a Town event or a non-profit organization event on condition that the Town approves of the location and it does not visually obstruct or jeopardize the safety of others. Any approved sign must be removed from the public roadway, boulevard or sidewalk within 24 hours of the event ending.


2. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect when adopted by Council.




