Town Update

The construction of the new Wastewater Facility continues at a robust pace. Estimated operational opening is November of this year.

The Town of Regina Beach receives \$64,427.60 in very specific financial assistance from the Government of Canada through the Province of Saskatchewan every year. The Town Council must designate this annual assistance, known as "Gas Tax Funding" for limited and specific purposes. Council has decided that this funding be designated to infrastructure projects throughout the Town.

In 2017 Town Council embarked on a number of projects, some of which are still to be completed and has designated future funding to undertake additional projects.

The following projects, with priority in order of appearance, are intended to be complete by the end of 2018

Work yet to be done from 2017

Drainage – 5th Ave from 14th St. E. to 16th St. E.

Drainage – 2nd St. W. from 3rd St. W. along MacMurphy Ave.

Drainage – 3rd St. E. and 2nd Ave. culvert repair

Drainage – 3rd St. W. – 1st phase

Drainage – 2nd St. W. Daly Ave. to Lake

New 2018 projects

Drainage – 200 Block Fairchild Ave.

Drainage - 9th St. E. – 4th Ave. to 5th Ave.

Drainage – 400 Block Fairchild Ave.

The total value of all projects is approximately \$190,000. Additions or deletions of projects may occur as costs are known.

Seasonal Water Turn Off

This year **Monday, October 1, 2018**, is the due date for seasonal water line turn off.

It is the residents' responsibility to schedule a water shut off.

As availability cannot be guaranteed, the earlier you schedule the better! A minimum of 48 hour advance notice is required.

If damages result from failure to schedule seasonal water shut off the property owner could be held accountable.

The Town is also asking all property owners to ensure their water meters are working. If you require repair, please contact the office to schedule an appointment.

Did you know Regina Beach Parks & Rec Board is holding a Chase the Ace lottery? A fundraiser with the goal to improve outdoor recreation and park space in Regina Beach.

Draw every Friday at 8:00 pm at Waterfront Bar & Grill \$5/ticket. Tickets are available for purchase on Fridays from 6:30-7:30 at the Waterfront Bar & Grill or in advance during regular business hours. Tickets can also be purchased at the Town Office Mon-Fri 9:00-3:30, Has Beans or any Parks & Rec Board member.

Chase the Ace is a progressive, multiple-draw raffle lottery in which participants purchase tickets for a chance to win a percentage of the proceeds from the sale of tickets for each draw (every Friday) and the opportunity to win a progressive jackpot by selecting a card from a standard deck of 52 playing cards.

The person who holds the winning ticket selected in each draw has an opportunity to select one playing card from the single deck. If the Ace of Spades is selected, in addition to winning a percentage of the proceeds from that draw, the person will win the progressive jackpot (up to a max of \$225,000). The lottery continues until such time as the Ace of Spades has been selected and the progressive jackpot has been awarded. At that point the event is concluded.
