Traffic Calming

The town strategy for 2019 is not to install any temporary speed bumps. We are following the recommendation of the Transportation Association of Canada and USA DOT. Other traffic calming techniques have proven more successful than speed bumps alone. We will be implementing a radar speed display sign which will display to drivers their current speed. The radar sign will record time, date and speed. That data will be invaluable in assessing future traffic calming needs and infrastructure improvement needs. The sign will be moved weekly to assess traffic patterns across the town.

Tax Discount

Bylaw No. 10/2010 to Establish Property Tax Incentives and Penalties provides for a 5% discount on the 2019 tax year for tax levies paid by the end of July.

Seasonal Water Turn Off

This year **Monday, September 30, 2019**, is the due date for seasonal water line turn off.

**It is the residents' responsibility to schedule a water shut off.**

As availability cannot be guaranteed, the earlier you schedule the better! Calls must be received by 3:00pm two business days prior to the date being requested.

Garbage

Garbage pick up begins at 7am. To guarantee pick up, garbage must be out by then. A few other things to note: garbage is to be in a garbage can/receptacle with a tight fitting lid; maximum 4 bags, bags not to exceed 35lbs. Removal of brush and bulk refuse is the responsibility of the landowner for disposal at the waste management site. Brush piles cannot accumulate for any longer than two weeks at a time.— Bylaw No. 1/2009

Unlicensed Vehicles

With the nice weather upon us, this is a reminder that as per provincial law, unlicensed vehicles (Golf Carts, ATV's, Dirt Bikes, etc.) are not to be driven within town limits. This is enforced by the RCMP. To report concerns, please call the RCMP at 306-731-4270.
